Course Description

Located in Escondido, the San Diego Archaeological Museum is the only local organization dedicated to the collection, curation, and exhibition of San Diego County's archaeological artifacts. The center has been in existence since the Curation Crisis of 1998 when there was a thirty year backlog of treasures that show us how people have lived in the area for the past 10,000 years. The docent-led tour will introduce us to a museum quality exhibit and educational programs available to researchers and the public as an important cultural resource.
