What You Can Do:

Secure your passwords. Use an app or learn this system.

(Grab paper and pen.)



Rules for A Safe Password

- 12-14 characters
- Upper and lower case letters

- Symbols
- Numbers

Step 1: Set aside an hour or two to conquer your passwords

Step 2:

Make a complete list of all of the websites where you use passwords.

Step 3:

Think of a **phrase** that will be the base of your passwords.

Try for 4-6 words.

Example:

Houston, we have a problem. You only live once. Don't believe everything you read.

Dog is man's best friend One day at a time. Keep calm and carry on. This too shall pass. Better to be safe than sorry Beyond a shadow of a doubt No pain, no gain. Chip off the old block Early bird catches the worm Every cloud has a silver lining Tomorrow is another day. Houston, we have a problem Do the right thing. Honesty is the best policy. Think before you speak. Like two peas in a pod Turn the other cheek. More bang for your buck A Penny for your thoughts

Put your best foot forward Wherefore art thou Romeo Sight for sore eyes The Road less travelled Short end of the stick The sky is the limit Tomorrow is another day Mary, John, Ann are my kids. Happy wife, happy life.

Step 4:Write down the first letter
of each word.
Capitalize the first word.

Example:

- Houston, we have a problem
- You only live once.
- Don't believe everything you read.

Step 5: Add a series of **4-6 numbers** that mean something to you.

Example:

- Houston, we have a problem.
- You only live once.
- Don't believe everything you read.

Hwhap**2035 1967**Yolo **9025**Dbeyr

Example:

Hwhap2035%% \$\$1967Yolo 9025Dbeyr**&&**

That is your **base** password for everything.

Memorize it.

If you must, only write this one down.

Step 7: The Secret

For every website, add **two letters** in the beginning (or end) for that password.

Example:

- Amazon Houston, we have a problem. Hwhap2035!!am
- Bank of America You only live once. ba\$\$1967Yolo
- Apple Don't believe everything you read. ap9025Dbeyr&&

Change All Passwords

- Log into everywhere you have a password.
- Find your account information or security setting.

- Reset or change the password.
- OR choose "forgot password."



Start with your bank accounts.

- Some banks limit symbols.
 - Bank of America does not allow !
- Find one that works.



Usernames

• Write them down if you must. No passwords.

• Use email or same username. Ex. jsmith









That's it.

- You will always know your password.
- No more password book for someone to find.

• Safe from hackers.
