Our Impact: How We are Changing the World

- 1) We are solving social isolation, an urgent health issue in the rapidly growing older adult population;
- 2) We are changing the life course of low income students so that they are successful in life;
- 3) We are helping Bridge the Digital Divide for seniors in need who benefit from technology; and
- 4) We are not duplicating anyone else's work; and
- 5) We are changing the way people think about aging.

Current Membership is 54,000. Membership is free. Class costs range from free to \$20 per class.

Program Highlights

- **Lifelong Learning**: 6,000 in-person and online classes annually at our two locations (La Mesa and Rancho Bernardo) and more than 30 off-site locations
- Healthy Living: workshops in fitness, dance, nutrition, life-style, and chronic disease management
- Intergenerational Tutoring Program: hundreds of trained volunteer tutors are helping at-risk children in grades K-4 build reading skills, self-esteem and positive attitudes toward learning. We serve Title 1 schools throughout the County, including San Diego, Chula Vista, La Mesa/Spring Valley, Poway/Rancho Bernardo, Ramona, and Escondido.
- Intergenerational Summer Camp: children and volunteers experience camp together in this award-wining, wholly unique intergenerational summer camp experience. The ultimate goal of this program is to develop reading and writing skills while promoting strong intergenerational bonds.
- Travel Program: day trips and extended trips are offered throughout the year.
- Bridging the Digital Divide: new tablets, training, internet, and free online classes are provided to low-income, isolated seniors who do not have any technology at home (~1100 tablets as of 7/2023).
