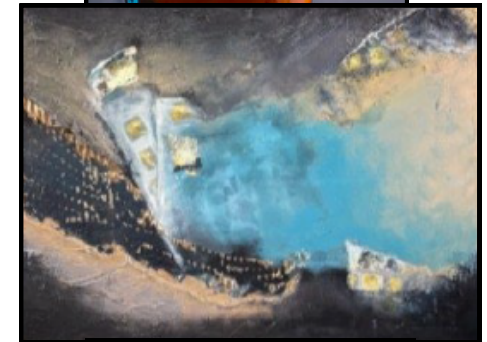

Diane DiSalvo Doonan studied under Salvatore Pecoraro at De Anza College in Cupertino, California, and earned her Bachelor's degree from San Jose State University in 1973. After a long and successful career as a medical office administrator and billing manager spanning more than thirty years, she returned to her artistic practice in retirement after raising two children with her husband, John.

Working primarily in acrylic painting, Doonan's work ranges widely in style, from realism to highly textured abstraction. An airbrush piece by the artist is included in the permanent collection of the Euphrates Gallery at De Anza College. Her artwork is also featured in the Armida Winery tasting room in Capitola, California.

Continuing education at Art on 30th has been a major source of inspiration, with her work frequently appearing in exhibitions where it has received honorable mentions and sales recognition. Doonan has exhibited at Woodward Contemporary Gallery, the San Diego Watercolor Society, the North Coastal Art Gallery in Carlsbad, and Art Scene West in Seaport Village, San Diego. The artist maintains a substantial and diverse body of work reflecting ongoing exploration across multiple visual styles and approaches.

Inspired by her adventures, from hiking in Sedona to gondola rides in Venice, Maureen's art invites viewers to explore the world through her unique perspective.

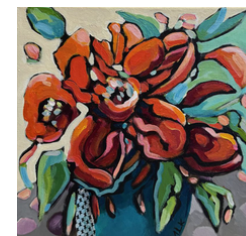
She teaches at Art on 30th and exhibits regularly at Ashton Gallery and other San Diego venues.



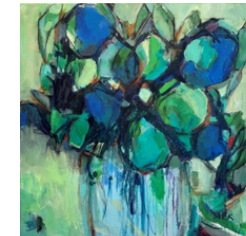
