### Day 1 To Philadelphia

Arrive in Philadelphia which in Greek translates to 'the city of brotherly love'. Meet your Tour Manager and transfer to your hotel for an overnight stay. The evening is at leisure.

### Day 2 Philadelphia / Amish (BD)

Today, enjoy a Philadelphia City Tour to see the Most Historic Square Mile in America. See Independence Hall, where the US Constitution was debated and adopted & the setting for the 1776 signing of the Declaration of Independence. Later, visit the Reading Terminal Market, Philadelphia's Market since 1893. This afternoon step back in time as you travel into Pennsylvania Amish Country. Visit an Amish Farm & House to learn about their faith, culture, distinctive dress and way of life. Enjoy a traditional Amish Family Style Dinner where the great food just keeps coming. Travel to Gettysburg to check into your hotel for a two-night stay.

### Day 3 Gettysburg (BD)

Visit the Gettysburg National Military Park Museum and Visitor Center and learn about the National Park's efforts to preserve the battlefield. Join a local guide who will bring to life the events at Gettysburg that turned the tide of the Civil War. The battlefield served as the backdrop for Abraham Lincoln's call for "a new birth of freedom" in his famed Gettysburg Address. Enjoy dinner this evening.

### Day 4 Shenandoah National Park (B)

This morning journey through the beautiful rolling hills of Shenandoah National Park. Enjoy the natural serenity as you drive along Skyline Drive, where the Blue Ridge Mountains stretch endlessly into the horizon, offering peaceful contrast to its stirring history. Later arrive in Charlottesville for an overnight stay with the evening at leisure to enjoy dinner on your own.

### Day 5 Monticello / Richmond (BD)

Visit Monticello and explore this neoclassical Italian-style estate where Thomas Jefferson once lived. Stop in Virginia's capital of Richmond and visit St John's Church, the very spot where George Washington and Thomas Jefferson were inspired by Patrick Henry's fiery "Give me

liberty or give me death" speech. Later arrive in Williamsburg, founded in 1638 as Middle Plantation. Check into your hotel for an overnight stay and enjoy dinner this evening.

### Day 6 Williamsburg / Mt. Vernon (B)

Step back in time and explore Colonial Williamsburg, once Britain's largest colony in the New World. See historical reenactors and artisans populate the streets and buildings, bringing 1770 to life. Enjoy free time for lunch on your own. Next, drive to Alexandria, Virginia to visit Mt. Vernon Estate and Gardens, President George Washington's beautiful estate overlooking the Potomac River. Later, arrive in Washington D.C., check into your hotel, and unpack for a three-night stay.

### Day 7 Washington D.C. (BD)

After breakfast, visit Arlington National Cemetery, America's shrine to valor and sacrifice. Board the tram to see the John F. Kennedy and Robert Kennedy graves plus the Changing of the Guard at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Then, stop at the Marine Corps Memorial (Iwo Jima Statue). This afternoon embark on a panoramic Washington D.C. city tour with a stop at The White House Visitor Center. You'll have an opportunity to view the film 'White House: Reflections from Within'. Also stop at four impressive Memorials: Jefferson, Franklin D. Roosevelt, M.L.K. Jr., and National WWII. Tonight, enjoy dinner with your fellow travelers.

### Day 8 D.C. / Illumination Tour (BD)

The day is free to relax or explore Washington D.C. on your own. Perhaps spend the day exploring and learning at the world-famous Smithsonian Institution Museums. Tonight, enjoy a Farewell Dinner this evening followed by a D.C. Twilight Illumination Tour of famous monuments. See the Capitol, the White House, the Jefferson Memorial, the Iwo Jima Marine Corps Memorial, the Kennedy Center and more. This is always a major highlight on any visit to Washington D.C.

### Day 9 Return Home (B)

Transfer to the airport today for your flight home filled with memories of America's Historic East.

FTCC is non-transferable, may not be redeemed for cash and does not include any credit for the Trip Cancellation Waiver Fee. **The Trip Cancellation Waiver Fee must be paid for with Initial Deposit and is refundable until 180 days prior to departure.** The Trip Cancellation Waiver does not cover any single supplement charges due to an individual's traveling companion canceling prior to departure. The Trip Cancellation Waiver is non-transferable and valid for each applicant only. The Trip Cancellation Waiver does not cover any services such as airline tickets not purchased through AFC. Cancellations, refunds & inquiries under Part A will be handled by AFC. Certain Exclusions and Restrictions apply.
